Changes are Chances: Windows 7

As Windows Vista was not well accepted in industries, Windows 7 seems to become the successor of Windows XP. With this approach a lot of users will not only move to Windows 7 but will take also full advantage of the new processors providing 64 bit technology.

At a first glance this does not look as a big difference because only addresses of objects change from 32 bit length to 64 bit. But it is a resulting fact that **64 bit applications cannot work with 32 bit DLLs.**

Therefore the **HartTools 7.0 do not work properly under Windows 7 (x64).**

HartTools 7.1: Solution for Windows 7 (x64)

HartTools 7.1 is a service package which contains all the required DLLs and executables which are required to run under Windows 7 (x64). The functionality is not changed at all thus allowing your applications to remain unchanged too. **HartTools 7.1** will be available by end of **March 2011**. Beta releases may be available earlier.

HartTools 7.0 (Hart Master/Slave DLL)

We are still providing the current 32 bit version of the HART tools Software to be used with all windows versions (including Windows 7 x86) and all versions of HART communication implementations including the support of all universal functionality in Hart 5, Hart 6 and Hart 7.
